EYFS begins the RE journey with enquiry based questions from Discovery RE.

In KS1 we follow Discovery RE where an enquiry based approach links closely with SMSC and British Values. Each enquiry addresses some aspect of Christian theology.

In KS2 we continue to follow Discovery RE where an enquiry approach adds challenge, requiring children to retain knowledge and apply it to the big question using their critical thinking skills.
