Dear Families,

We have been reviewing our GDPR practices and policies in school and would like to ensure that all information is accurate and up to date.

We have previously gathered consent from parents with regards to using photographs on the different platforms in school, moving forward we want to ensure that our information is accurate. Please see the statement below:

“We regularly take photographs of our pupils as part of our public duty. We may use these images in our prospectus and in other printed publications that we produce. Photographs of children are used for their learning experience and to show educational activities and achievements.

Photographs will be displayed in school, in newsletters, on the website and on social media. We may also make video or webcam recordings for educational use.

Occasionally the media will take photographs or film footage of a school profile event. Pupils will often appear in these images.

We are aware that it is essential that photographs are taken and stored appropriately to safeguard the children in our care.

We take our duty of care towards our school community very seriously. It is of our utmost importance. If you have any Safeguarding concerns regarding personal images and information being displayed, please do contact us so that we can respond appropriately”

We will be removing the parent consent section from Arbor with regards to photographs. If you wish for your child’s photo **not to be used** on the above platforms then please email KPJA-Admin@KPIA.inmat.org.uk and we will update your child’s records. All emails must be received by Monday 23rd January 2023.
