Kettering Mosque

Year 6 are currently learning about the Islamic faith as part of their Religious Education lessons. We are lucky enough to have the opportunity to visit the Mosque in Kettering as part of our learning on Thursday 16th June. Our afternoon visit will allow the children to observe a prayer session, as well as explore the building and find out about the daily activities within the Mosque.

There is no cost involved for this trip as we will be walking to the Mosque. We will be having a slightly earlier lunch time to allow us to do this. In order to allow an earlier lunchtime to occur, please may we ask that any children who have a lunch provided by the school order a packed lunch on that day, rather than a 'hot' school lunch (this will allow us to receive the food slightly earlier and leave earlier). Class teachers will send a reminder out (via Dojo) about this nearer the time. We plan to leave school at 12:20pm and will return slightly later than normal by 3:15pm. As the children will be walking a medium sized distance, please ensure they are wearing suitable shoes. The children will be required to wear their school uniform as usual.

Before your child goes on this trip, please ensure we have up to date contact details and medical records for them, as we will be taking current information from our internal records.
