Dear Families,

I am writing to inform you of the expectations set by the school for homework.

Homework will be set weekly and sent to your child electronically. Your child will receive all of the relevant login details they need to access the work at home. Please do not hesitate to ask your child's class teacher for support with this if needed.

The following expectations have been agreed for Maths homework:

- Daily times tables practise on Times-Tables Rock Stars. Years 3 and 4 will be allocated their times tables. Children in Years 5 and 6 may also be asked to practice particular tables on request of the teacher. (At least 10mins a day)
- MyMaths - weekly tasks will be set. This work will be relevant and linked to the teaching that has taken place in class that week
- Children are also free to challenge themselves and play other games on MyMaths if they so wish.

The following expectations have been agreed for English homework:

- Daily home reading – reading should be recorded in Reading Record books. (At least 10mins a day)
- Weekly Spelling frame – To complete the games and activities set that relate to the weekly spelling set by the class teacher.

Homework will be set on a Thursday to be completed and submitted by Tuesday the following week. Any feedback on homework will also be given electronically, when required, by your child's class teacher.

The completion of homework is an expectation of the school. We do however understand that there are sometimes mitigating circumstances when your child may not be able to complete homework. If this is the case please inform your child's class teacher. Where teachers have not been informed children will be required to attend the homework club to complete their homework which is held at lunchtimes.
